The United States Youth Archery Team just competed at the World Youth Archery Championships in Kundu-Antalya, Turkey from October 6-12. When the championship was over the Jr. USAT team bested the world in the medal count bringing home 6 Gold medals and 2 Silver medals. Kailey Johnston (GA, left) won Gold in the Compound Cadet Women's division and Kendal Nicely (ME, right) won Gold in the Compound Junior Women's division beating Samantha Pruitte (GA) who took the Silver Medal and on the men's side, Joey Hunt III (ME, lower right center) won Gold in the Compound Cadet

In the team competition the US teams were also victorious led by the Compound Cadet Men's team of Levi Cyr (ME), Joey Hunt III (ME) and Connor Kelly (CA) who set a new world record shooting a 233 total in all three of their matches. The Compound Cadet Women's team of Keiley Johnston (GA), Paige Pearce (CA) and Tristan Skarvan (WI) also brought home Gold as did the Compound Junior Women's team of Kendal Nicely (ME), Seneca Francis (UT) and Samantha Pruitte (GA). The Compound Junior Men's team of Adam Gallant (ME), Adam Wruck (MN) and Ben Cleland (OH) brought home the Silver medal.
